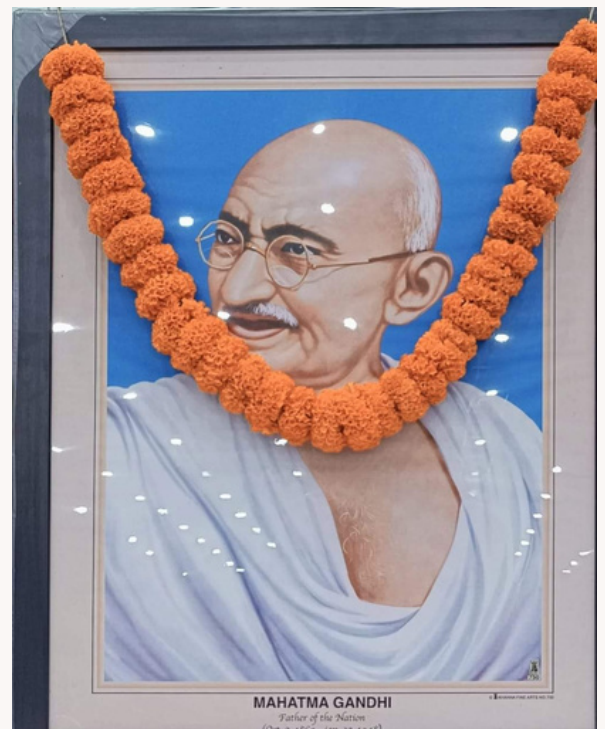

Litera Valley School was the first Runner-up of the championship.

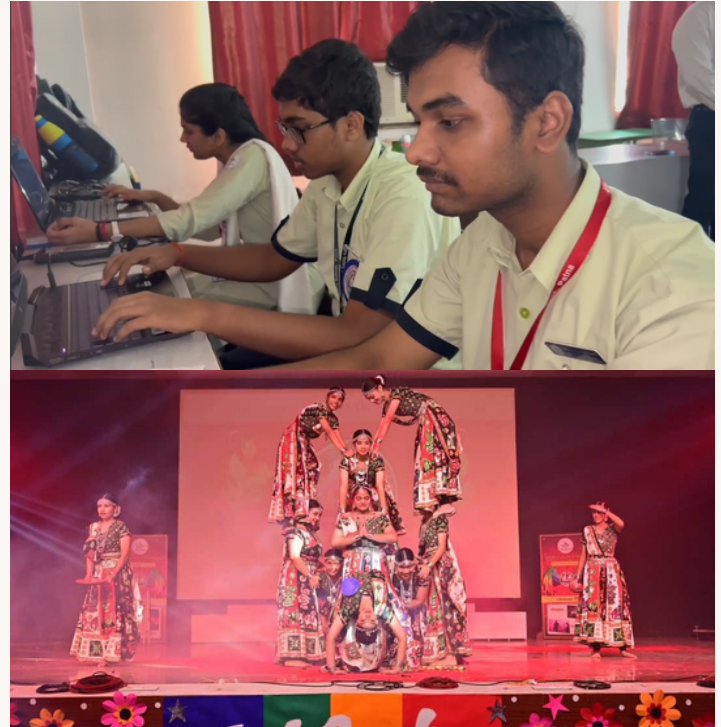
Competitive Excitement: House-Wise Trials Ignite Athletes at Litera Valley
